| OUR<br>SCHOOL<br>UNIFORM | Winter<br>Grey trousers or skirt, white CTK polo shirt, maroon CTK sweater/cardigan, black<br>school shoes (no trainers), grey socks/tights, plain hair bobbles.   |

|                          | Grey trousers/shorts, white polo shirt, maroon sweater/cardigan, black school shoes,   |
|                          | grey socks.<br>A red checked summer dress with white socks may also be worn.(No open toe sandals)  |
|                          | <b>Outdoor Clothing</b><br>Children should bring a coat to school each day, apart from during the hotter weather.  |
|                          | Footwear   |
|                          | Flat black shoes suitable for active play.<br>Dark trainers for Outdoor PE.  |
|                          | <b>P.E. and Games Kit</b><br>All children have the right to exercise and be safe therefore:  |
|                          | It the responsibility of children, parents and carers to ensure that the correct Christ<br>the King PE uniform is worn at all times: maroon PE shorts, white t-shirt and black<br>pumps, plain black jogging pants/leggings may be worn in the cold weather and an<br>optional CTK maroon hoodie |
|                          | • For swimming a full costume or trunks above the knee must be worn for safety.  |
|                          | All long hair should be tied back.   |
|                          | All children have a right to learn therefore:  |
|                          | • For safety reasons, children are <b>not</b> permitted to wear jewellery in school. This  |

|  | <ul> <li>includes earrings. Clear plastic spacers may be worn. If a child needs to wear a piece of jewellery for medical or religious reasons, it should be removed or covered up during physical activity with a letter written to explain the reason;</li> <li>Nail polish, hair gel, jewellery other than watches, should not be worn;</li> <li>Shoulder length hair and longer should be tied back neatly, with plain maroon or black bobble. Small bows/headbands may be worn in school colours. Hair should not be any shorter than a number two.</li> </ul> |

| BOOKS &<br>BAGS  | <ul> <li>All children are to use a smart, maroon briefcase-style bag or a CTK rucksack for carrying their reading books, pencils and belongings;</li> <li>Large bags should not be brought into school.</li> </ul>   |
