## Starter: The story so far

What else do you notice in the illustration?

Why do you think the crows could be perched on top of the cave? Compare their positions with that of the other animals that Leaf has encountered during the book so far.

How do they feel about Leaf?

Are they judging him, protecting him, guarding, supporting, comforting?
Can they see his vulnerability? And, if so, why can they see it but not the other

animals?



### Sentence type: Short

Today we are going to learn a new sentence type.

The short sentence type can be really effective when used alongside other sentences. You shouldn't use it over and over again but when you add it around other sentences it can have a very big impact.

When we use the short sentence type we use either 1-3 words and we add an exclamation mark or a question mark

Everything failed!
Leaf was lost!
Leaf began crying!
He was miserable!
Was he ok?
