Weekly Reflection

Ethos Statement – I can use words that make the world a better place

This week we reflected on how easy it was to cheer each other up with a kind word of thanks or praise. We were given the mission to go out and try extra hard to choose the right words both at home and at school.

One of the smallest words we can say that makes a great difference is 'sorry'. Sometimes we say it so guickly and so often that we do not really think about what we are saying and we do not always truly mean it. Jesus tells us that we need to be contrite – truly sorry for what we do wrong and that when we are sorry we should not only use the word but try and make up for our mistakes by changing our behaviour too. In the story of The Prodigal Son we learn how God is there waiting for us to come back to him and say we are sorry. If we do, then he will always forgive us no matter what we have done wrong. If it has been a while since you last went to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, then perhaps you could consider seeking God's love in this special way. If you have not made your First Reconciliation yet, then maybe you could say a little sorry prayer to God.
