
### Dunelm Competition Winners!

## Weekly Reflection

In Matthew's Gospel we hear Jesus' beautiful invitation, "Come to me...and I will give you rest." It is a suitable theme near the end of the school year - a year in which all schools have had very unexpected burdens and rest! We are encouraged, even in difficult and unusual times, to hand over our concerns to Jesus and to rest in God's presence.



Very soon, we will start our long holiday – six weeks of rest! Usually everyone would be really excited for this, but this year might feel a bit different. Perhaps you feel like you've already had a long holiday at home this year! Maybe the idea of another six weeks makes you feel bored. In daily life, we have a routine (even in lockdown!) We get up, we do our schoolwork, we eat, play, sleep, get up, do our schoolwork. And it carries on. We are used to having activities planned for us. When that routine stops – for a long holiday, for example - it might feel a bit funny. We might wonder what to do with ourselves. Maybe we want to fill the time with activities. But Jesus tells us that it is also good to rest. We don't always have to be doing something. Only God can do everything! He wants us to hand over our concerns and our tiredness to Him.

We are all much in need of a rest; even if you have been at home you have still been working hard. Our teachers and adults in school have been working in a very different way to usual but they have still been as busy as ever. So the summer holidays will bring a welcome break. Let us pray that we are able to hand over our worries and concerns to God as we take some time to relax at home with our families before we start another busy school year together.
