ETHOS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All children have the right to an education.• It the responsibility of children, parents and carers to ensure that the correct Christ the King uniform is worn at all times.• It is the responsibility of Christ the King Primary School staff to promote high expectations, which includes the wearing of the school uniform. <p>At Christ the King Primary School, we believe that a school uniform is important because it:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Contributes to a sense of belonging• Gives a common purpose• Fosters a feeling of pride• Looks smart
OUR SCHOOL UNIFORM	<p style="text-align: center;">Winter</p> <p>Grey trousers or skirt, white CTK polo shirt, maroon CTK sweater/cardigan, black school shoes (no trainers) , grey socks/tights, plain hair bobbles.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Summer</p> <p>Grey trousers/shorts, white polo shirt, maroon sweater/cardigan, black school shoes, grey socks. A red checked summer dress with white socks may also be worn.(No open toe sandals)</p> <p>Outdoor Clothing Children should bring a coat to school each day, apart from during the hotter weather.</p> <p>Footwear Flat black shoes suitable for active play. Dark trainers for Outdoor PE.</p> <p>P.E. and Games Kit All children have the right to exercise and be safe therefore:</p> <p>It the responsibility of children, parents and carers to ensure that the correct Christ the King PE uniform is worn at all times: maroon PE shorts, white t-shirt and black pumps, plain black jogging pants/leggings may be worn in the cold weather and an optional CTK maroon hoodie</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• For swimming a full costume or trunks above the knee must be worn for safety. All long hair should be tied back. <p>All children have a right to learn therefore:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• For safety reasons, children are not permitted to wear jewellery in school. This

	<p>includes earrings. Clear plastic spacers may be worn. If a child needs to wear a piece of jewellery for medical or religious reasons, it should be removed or covered up during physical activity with a letter written to explain the reason;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nail polish, hair gel, jewellery other than watches, should not be worn; • Shoulder length hair and longer should be tied back neatly, with plain maroon or black bobble. Small bows/headbands may be worn in school colours. Hair should not be any shorter than a number two.
BOOKS & BAGS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All children are to use a smart, maroon briefcase-style bag or a CTK rucksack for carrying their reading books, pencils and belongings; • Large bags should not be brought into school.


