## Measuring the impact of PPG spending

The school's Senior Leaders will evaluate the impact of pupil premium spending throughout the year. Monitoring will focus on academic performance and the extent to which a child's self-confidence has developed as a consequence of support received and the contribution to educational gains.

End of Key Stage data will be analysed to determine how well pupils for whom the pupil premium grant is received perform in relation to their peers locally and nationally.
