
FS2 topic activities – Mini Beasts: Yucky Worms





Draw a big picture of a worm and write around it all of the things you and your family know about them (adult might need to scribe some facts!).

Then watch the story / listen to the facts and add the ones you remember to your chart. Did you find a lot more facts?

Make a wormery https://youtu.be/0519RpG1D_k

You need:

A plastic drink bottle (adults cut the neck off but kept for a lid)

Cut up paper

Sand (if you have it to make extra layers)

Soil

Vegetable scraps (good to add on top)

Water

Become a wormologist! Go on a worm hunt in your garden or a safe green space when you go for a walk.

How could you make the worms come to the surface? How will make sure you don't hurt the worms?

- Write a sentence about the worm (can you write more than one?)

Tell me the facts you love the most about worms! My sentence is:

A worm has five pairs of hearts and if it is cold it curls up with other worms to keep warm.
