This is what a Roman writer called Cassius Dio wrote about her

She was a tall woman, with piercing eyes and a loud voice. A
great mass of red hair hung down below her waist. Round her
neck was a large gold torc (like a really thick necklace made to
look like a metal rope). She wore a full, flowing tartan dress,
and over it was a cloak, fastened by a brooch.

He didn't draw a picture. In fact there are no pictures of her from the time. The ones we have in books were all drawn or painted much later.
