

Super Sentence Stackers: Joy Story

Last term we were thinking all about kindness. Today I would like you to have a think about that whilst working on your English writing skills. I would like you to watch a beautiful film that thinks about 'making joy happen'.

You are going to create your own sentences about a small part of this film. I would like you to include the following sentence types:

- 1. A simile- saying something is like something else (Example: The stars in the night sky twinkled like diamonds).
- 2. Sound senses description- (Example: Water lapped softly against the bow of the boat.)
- 3. A complex sentence using 'because' (Example: Her owner looked down furiously at her because she was scaring the fishes away with her shrill barks.)
