Happy Monday year 3,

This weeks Super Sentence Stackers is based on a short pixar film called 'One man band'. Last week lots of you had a go at creating a piece of writing based on a clip!

Try to include- Some of the things to include are a little tricky; but don't worry the lesson explains them really clearly. See if you can include one or more of these:

1. A metaphor- this is similar to a simile but instead of saying it is like something we say it is something else. (Example: The musicians drew their musical instruments and prepared for battle.)
2. Purpose oxymoron- Use contradictory vocabulary, add a positive word to a negative sentence such as melody. Melody is a nice sound. (Example: Tippy cowered at the atrocious melody.)
3. Prefix of suffix (Example: The clash and the clang was unbearable/ The shrill ring and crash of the instruments as they attacked Tippy's ears was dreadful.)
