Since we are God's most precious treasure then He will not let us go hungry either. Worrying will not add any time to our lives, but will only take away from the time that we could spend serving God. In Matthew's Gospel, it tells us that the Lord knows what we need. God knows exactly what we need before we even ask for it. God wants us to seek His kingdom and when we do we will learn more about Him and will follow His will for our lives. When we are seeking God, He will make sure that we have everything that we need. He loves us and will provide for our needs.

God created all things in nature. Can you think of different things he created in nature using each letter of the alphabet? 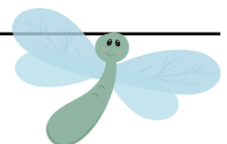
