“All the better to eat you with,” said the wolf.

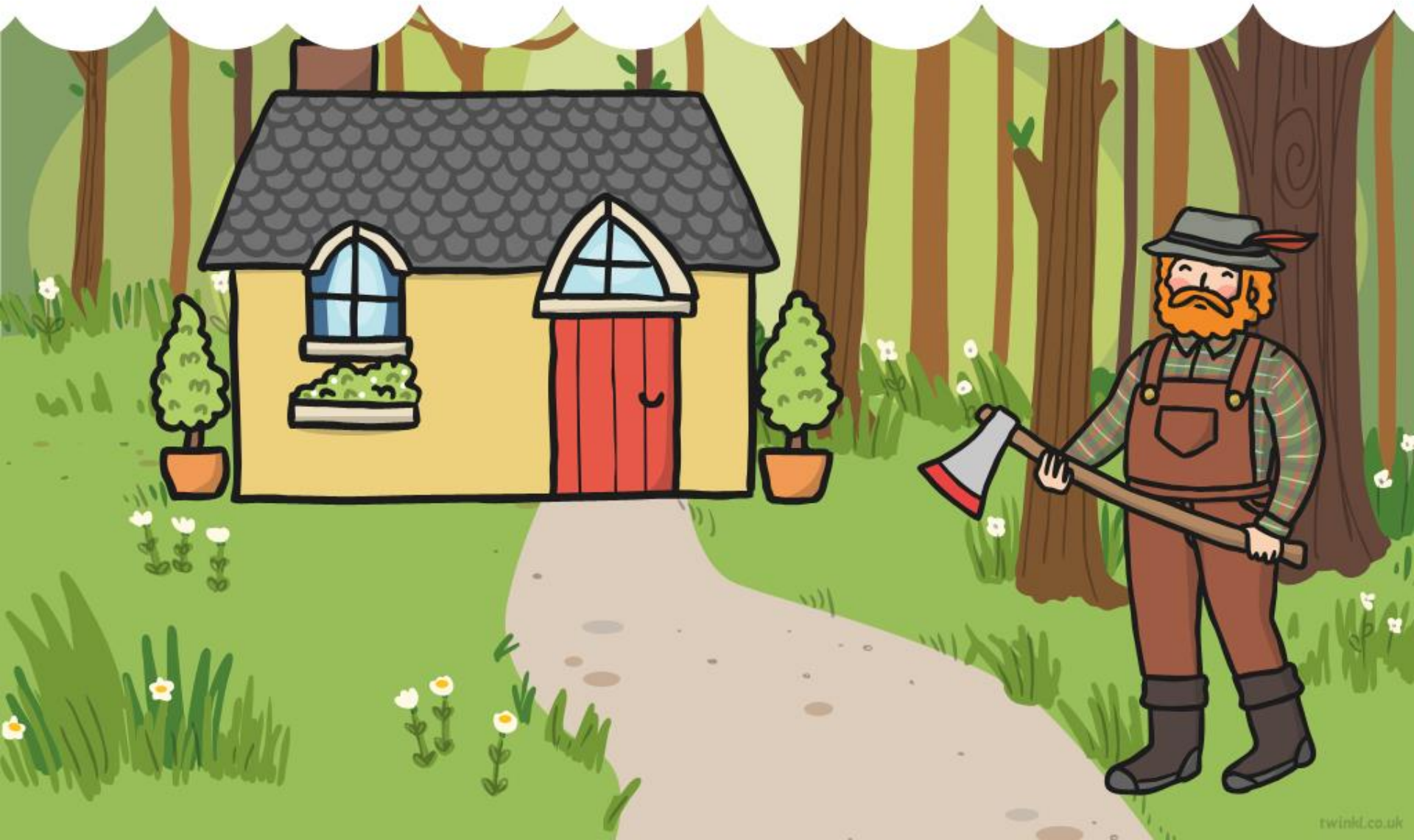


“Help!” shouted Little Red Riding Hood as she realised that there was a wolf in her grandmother’s bed.

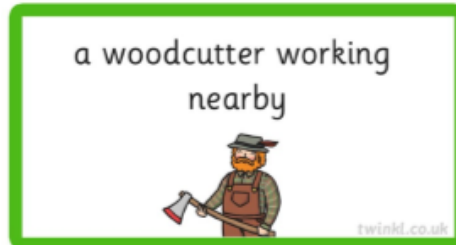
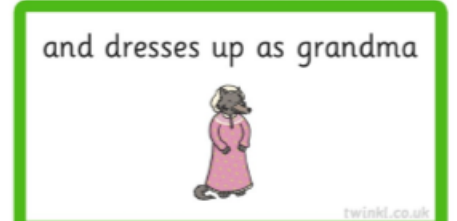
